Class descriptions

Specials Classes: These classes are open to all dogs but are intended for dogs that are of a size or stature that limits their jumping ability. A dog may no longer compete in standard titling classes after being entered at an official trial in any Special class except that they may move to **Veterans**.

Veterans Classes; These classes shall be for dogs seven years of age or older that are currently competing in any Standard Agility Class and for dogs five years of age or older who have competed in the Specials Agility Class for a minimum of one calendar year.

General Notice to Exhibitors

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of A.A.C. rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following:

- This event is held under AAC rules & regulations and is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs showing signs of aggression.
- Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC and shall conform to AAC specifications.

- All dogs must have an official A.A.C. Identification card, which must be produced at measure in. Any dog without a card, with a card pending, under two years of age, and with out two official measurements on their ID card must be measured before competing. A dog over 23'' at the withers can have a signed ID card before two years of age.
- No leads, collars, food, toys or any other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and or children. Any exhibitor, whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may be asked to leave the trial grounds and NO REFUND of fees paid will be made.
- Exhibitors must keep crate and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourselves and your dogs.
- The host club reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- There will be no refunds, cancellations or changes after the closing date, except for move-ups as per AAC regulations.
- Any dog earning a title after the closing date of this trial is eligible to move up to the next level as long as the exhibitor notifies the secretary at least one week prior to the trial. A dog earning a title on the Saturday of this trial is allowed to move up on Sunday, as long as the secretary is notified before the completion of the trial on Saturday.

PLEASE NOTE:

Abuse in any form, of the volunteers, competitors or the judge will NOT be TOLERATED!! Anyone disrupting the trial due to poor sportsmanship or abusive behavior will be DISMISSED from the trial, no fees will be refunded and any legs earned to that point will be null.

STANDSURE / 3D DISTRIBUTORS COVID PROTOCOL

The following protocol will be in place for this trial (please note, this list may be updated):

- All attending will have to wear masks with the following exceptions:
 - The judge (while in the ring judging)
 - The competitor in the ring
 - While eating or drinking (please ensure social distancing)
- If you are feeling unwell, have a cough, a temperature etc, please pull from the trial.
- During walk thru, masks are to be worn, social distancing is to be adhered to.
- We will NOT have extra masks, you must bring your own. Anyone attending without a mask will have to leave, you will not be issued a refund and will not be allowed back in until you have a mask.
- Only competitors and the judge will be allowed in the facility.
- Ribbons will be self serve, as per usual.
- The judge, timer/scribe and competitor will be the only ones in the ring during a run, there will be no ring crew within the ring. When it is either a course change or a height change, please just jump into the ring and get the job done. There will be hand sanitizer bottles just outside the ring so you can get your hands done immediately after handling the equipment.
- One person can scribe and time, the exception being Gamblers as it is easier for 2 people to do these jobs. During Gamblers, the chairs will be placed 6' apart.
- Washrooms will have paper towel to dry your hands.
- Kenneling will only be in the dock area. The dock will have outlined spaces to help us with social distancing.
- If weather allows, the overhead door(s) may be opened.
- Bring your lunch, there will be no lunch provided.
- The kitchen area will ultimately be cleared of anything, so bring whatever you need to eat your meals please. All the cutlery, napkins, etc will be put away.
