For handlers withdrawing for medical reasons a refund will be issued if the space can be filled. All refunds are subject to a \$5 per entry day processing fee.

### **Titles:**

All three (3) components (Container, Interior, and Exterior) must be successfully completed (qualifying scores earned) to earn the SD-S, SD-A or SD-E title. The SP (Special) designation will be added to the title of any dog that completes the three components on the same day, at the same trial. For Elite (SD-EL) all 3 components must be passed on the same day.

### **Awards and Prizes**

Qualifying ribbons will be presented per component.  
SDDA New Title rosettes will be awarded for new titles in all levels.

**Order of Events** (subject to change at the hosts discretion) Classes will run as follows:

Saturday: Started, Advanced, Excellent  
Sunday: Elite, Started, Advanced, Excellent

### **Crating:**

**NO INDOOR CRATING WILL BE AVAILABLE**

**No Shows:** Are considered competitors who are not present at the time of their level briefing and who have not made contact with the trial secretary to give notice. No show spaces will be made available to those who may have showed up for day of entries.

### **Same Day and Next Day Move Ups**

Competitors who were already registered for Sunday and who successfully complete their level on Saturday may move up on Sunday.

**SAME DAY MOVE UPS WILL BE ALLOWED SPACE AND TIME PERMITTING.**

### **COVID-19 Rules, Policies and Guidelines for Participants**

BEFORE YOU ENTER THIS TRIAL: You must read this COVID-19 plan completely, and indicate on your entry form that you have read and understand it. If you do not understand something, please contact kingfisher@sasktel.net The rules, policies and guidelines in this document will be in place for all PAKOC events held during the COVID-19 pandemic. Failure to follow federal, provincial, local or club orders, rules, policies and guidelines may result in dismissal from the event. We have a zero tolerance policy for 'playing while sick'. Competitors will recognize that masks are NOT a replacement for distancing, barriers and handwashing. The most common symptoms of COVID-19 include: fever; chills; cough or worsening of chronic cough; shortness of breath; sore throat; runny nose; loss of sense of smell or taste; headache; fatigue; diarrhea; loss of appetite; nausea and vomiting; muscle aches. While less common, symptoms can also include: stuffy nose; conjunctivitis (pink eye); dizziness, confusion; abdominal pain; skin rashes or discoloration of fingers or toes.

Prohibited from the site:

- anyone who has had symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 10 days
- anyone who has been directed by Public Health to self-isolate
- anyone who has arrived from outside of Canada in the 14 days before trial
  - anyone living with someone who meets the previous criteria
- Only the judge, handler and required volunteers will be allowed in search areas.

No outside photo/ video person permitted during the pandemic.

- Walk-through's are limited to only those people running in the component. Groups may be split up.
  - Maintain a distance of 2m from others at all times.
- Participants should bring their own lunches, drinks and water for their own comfort. There are plenty of stores and restaurants nearby.

**Non-medical masks are REQUIRED** at all times, regardless of public health measures that may be in place at the time of the trial

- You must provide a phone number and address for contact tracing purposes.

All Participants of this event agree to abide by the following points when entering trial facilities and/or participating in PAKOC events:

- I agree to stay home if I am feeling sick.
- I have read and understand the PAKOC COVID-19 Rules, Policies and Guidelines.
  - I agree to abide by PAKOC COVID-19 Rules, Policies and Guidelines.
- I agree to bring my own non-medical mask, and will use it in required areas at the trial.
- I understand that if I do not abide by the aforementioned policies/guidelines, that I may be dismissed from the trial site.
